- From **6pm-7pm** we are inviting the children to a Reading Slumber Party. Children can return to school in their pyjamas, with a pillow/teddy bear and most importantly a good book! With biscuit treats and a glass of chocolate milk, the children can divulge into imaginary worlds and share discovered adventures with their friends.

Book Week Fundraising Appeal.

We are organising a variety of different activities to fundraise for books across the whole school. Thank you for all the support you have given in the past and hope that you will support us on our next project.

- **Sponsored "Listen and Read" by Usborne Books.**

Working in partnership with Usborne Books the children have been asked to take part in a sponsored Read and Listen. They can ask their aunts, uncles, friends, grandparents (the list goes on and on!) to sponsor them for every minute of a book they read or listen too.
