Re: Parents Evening – 18 and 19 March 2020 & future trips

Dear Parents

I am writing to inform you that after careful consideration, parents' evening will be postponed to next term, because of the current Coronavirus crisis.

To keep you informed of your child's progress and attainment, class teachers will be writing a brief mid-year report. This will give you key information and targets to work on and the report will go out to you, by the end of March. We will rearrange meetings in the summer term and will give you the opportunity to look at work and meet with class teachers.

With regard to future trips, regrettably, we have decided to cancel the Year 2 trip to Margaret Clitherow Church on Tuesday, 17th March 2020. We are taking advice and speaking to Hindleap, with regard to the Year 4 residential trip, scheduled to take place at the end of March. Parents of pupils due to attend this trip, will be informed of outcomes as soon as possible.

Sadly, we will have to postpone the mothers' day breakfast, (due to be held on, Thursday, 19th March 2020) and will arrange another date, once things are more settled. School Mass will be for junior children in the Junior Hall, on Thursday at 10.00 a.m. The infants will have a special assembly to mark St Joseph's Feast day.

I regularly receive updates from Gov.Uk, PHE and the Local Authority. All decisions made, with regard to trips, or potential closure of the school, is based on up to date information and Government directives.

Should we need to close the school, you will be notified as soon as possible, and a link will be activated on our School Website under year groups. It will be called 'Learning at home' and will have activities for your child to complete. Each child will be given paper or a book to complete the work on. You will need access to a computer and the internet to access tasks. You may wish to print off the tasks, or alternatively view them on screen and complete the work on paper, or in the book provided, to avoid unnecessary printing.

If you do not have access to the internet, kindly let the school office know as soon as possible, so alternative arrangements can be made.

I appreciate it is a difficult time but thank you for your support and I ask that you keep all those who are affected by the virus in your prayers, together with all the medical staff and those supporting people during this crisis.
