READING Decoding
To read Speed Sounds Set 1, 2 and 3. Apply phonic knowledge until automatic decoding has become embedded and reading is fluent Read accurately words with common suffixes & more than two syllables Aware that certain combinations of letters sound differently in different words, e.g. bread and read To decode and read real and pseudo words with speed sounds se
Word Recognition
To read 200 year 1/2 high frequency words
Comprehension & Understanding
Read ahead for fluency and expression Recount main themes /events. Comment on structure of text; both fiction and non-fiction Listen to, discuss and express views about a wide range of text types Continue to build upon repertoire of poems learnt by heart Predict and make inferences on the basis of what has been read
Deducing
Self correct when mistake is made Know if reading refers to present or past.
Intonation & Expression
Use commas, question marks and exclamation marks to vary expression Read aloud with expression and intonation Re-read books to build up fluency and confidence
Grammatical features
Identify speech marks in reading and understand purpose
Research
Use contents & index to find information

# WRITING

### Sentence structure

Write compound sentences.

Use and & then to join ideas.

Use time connectives such as 'before', 'meanwhile' etc. subordination (when, if, that, because) and coordination (and, or, but).

# Text

Use appropriate text structures for different text types. Plan, draft, write and revise compositions.

### Paragraphing

Use structures from reading. Write instructions and non-chronological reports Label diagrams.

# **Spelling & Phonics**

To segment real and pseudo words with speed sounds set 1, 2 and 3 sounds in it, then write the words. Simple, monosyllabic words spelt correctly. Inaccuracies are phonetically plausible.

### **Punctuation**

Use capital letters, full stops, question marks & exclamation marks Use commas in list Use of apostrophes

#### Grammar

Use present & past tense consistently & correctly. Write with grammatical agreement (matching verbs to nouns/ pronouns). Use standard forms of verbs, e.g. go/went.

#### Handwriting

Letters are accurately formed & consistently sized correct spacing within and between words Use cursive script

#### **Speaking and Listening**

Show confidence in talking, particularly where topics interest them. Show awareness of the needs of the listener by including relevant detail. Listen carefully and respond with increasing appropriateness to what others say. Develop and explain ideas Speak clearly and use a growing vocabulary. Can use gesture and props & create a character (role play)
