Dear parents and carers

I hope you're looking forward to a relaxing summer and spending time together as a family. Do remember that school breaks up on Thursday, 22nd July at 1.30 p.m. and term will start on Monday, 6th September 2021 at 8.45 a.m. Nursery begins the later in the week - Wednesday 8th September 2021

I wanted to share arrangements with you for the new term based on current advice. Should this change for any reason, I will write to you in August with updated information.

Drop off and pick up times

School will begin for all pupils at 8.45 a.m. Infant and Nursery children will finish at 3.00 p.m. and junior pupils at 3.15 p.m.

<u>Infant and Nursery children - 8.45 a.m. – 3.00 p.m.</u>

Children attending the infant school should enter via the Crown Dale playground entrance. Y1 and Y2 pupils will walk into school unaccompanied and will be met by a member of staff. Nursery and Reception pupils may be accompanied to their classroom.

End of day collection 3.00 p.m.

Parents collecting Nursery and Infant children should enter via the Crown Dale playground entrance and collect children from the classroom door. Staff will be there to direct you to avoid too many people waiting outside the classroom. Once you have collected your child, please leave via the infant gate at Woodend.

If you need to collect junior children, please exit via the infant Woodend gate and enter through the Woodend junior gate making your way to the junior playground. Staff will also be available at the gate and entrance to the junior playground, to direct and ease congestion. Please then exit at the end of the junior playground past the Garden Hall.

Junior children – 8.45 – 3.15 p.m. 3.15 p.m.

Juniors will enter via the junior gate at Woodend in the morning and will walk into the junior playground unaccompanied. Years 5 & 6 will enter via the playground door. Years 3 & 4 via the door opposite the Garden hall.

End of the day collection - 3.15 p.m.

Pupils in years 3 to 6 will be brought into the playground and line up in designated areas. Please avoid blocking path ways and give children sufficient time and distance to be dismissed safely.

Children in years 5 and 6 walking home alone, will need parental consent in writing.

We will be sending out a parent questionnaire in September to find out your views on use of the difference school entrances and other procedures. So please do take time to answer questions. We hope to send it out the third week in September.

P.E. Days

Children in all years from Reception to year 6 must come into school wearing their full PE kit on days when they have P.E. or after-school clubs and will not need to change into uniform. Please refer to our website or your own copy of the school handbook for a full uniform list.
