





Girls Only Wildcats Football Club- Year 4-6

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to announce our new Wildcats after school club at St Josephs Primary School!

Wildcats is a FA programme delivered across the country. Wildcats are Girls' Football Centres that provide girls aged 5 to 11 years old with the opportunity to have fun, make friends and play football. The sessions are a great opportunity to welcome new girls into the game in a fun, safe, friendly environment.

This Wildcats club is organised by the Palace for Life Foundation (Crystal Palace's official charity) with the aim of engaging more girls in football at a starter level, as well as improving their confidence in a sporting environment.

This new Wildcats Football club will be starting on **Monday 10th January** for girls in **Years 4-6**, and will run till **Monday 23rd May**. The sessions will be held every **Monday** at the school from **3:15-4:15pm**. Your child will need to have a full PE kit in school in order to participate in the club.

We will be following government guidance and working with the school to ensure our club is a Covid-19 secure environment. Our coaches will be equipped with hand sanitizer, and equipment will be cleaned at regular intervals. Activities will be delivered using social distance guidelines, ensuring your child has a safe and fun experience.

The cost for the club is **£1** per a session, for the Autumn term it will be £15 for 15 weeks. Please book by credit/debit card on our website http://www.palaceforlife.org/. ***Please note bookings are only taken for the full 15-week programme, bookings cannot be made for individual sessions.**

There are 16 places available for this club, therefore places will be on a first come, first served basis.
