# SUNKEN SHIPS

Ernest Shackleton was an amazing sailor exploring the seven seas and the deepest, darkest, coldest oceans. He is well known for his wonderful adventures of the South Pole with his brave crewmates who volunteered willingly and had a taste for Shackleton's profession. They adventured to the South Pole on his boat the Endurance on August 1914.

Shackleton and his crew arrived at Antarctica but unfortunately they had got there just before the beginning of WW1.

They made impact and collided into the thick dry packed ice which had made the Entrance sealed and frozen in place. The terrain was freezing with sheets of ice and toweringly tall glaciers and it was so cold that your whole body would have gone numb. The cold air froze upon the thick wood of the ship which just made it more frozen in place. Even if they had the Endurance out of the ice they couldn't go home because of



the WW1. dead including their cat.

They had to survive of seals and penguins after running out of food. Shackleton and his crew spent 18 full months trying and failing to dig up their old ice. The water pressure made the Endurance would be crushed. On October 27th 1914 they salvaged anything from the boat that they could use to survive long enough to get back home and then abandoned it. On March 30th 1915 they had to kill and eat 5 of their own dogs but by October 20th 1915 all their dogs were

On April 24th 1916 Shackleton and 2 other crewmates traveled 900 miles to South Georgia island to find civilization. Unfortunately they were on the wrong side of the island when they saw people who helped them. Then they went back to save their friends and then he was known as a hero. 6 years later in 1922 Shackleton died of a heart attack.
