Our learning in all subjects is inspired by high quality story books. Each half term we will share a suggested reading list including the books that we will share together in class and others that you can share at home to support the children's learning and understanding of our topics.

PE & Forest School Days

This term our reception class will have their PE lessons on a Wednesday and Forest School on Monday's. Children will need to come into school in their PE kits on these days. Outdoor learning is an important part of our early years curriculum and we kindly ask that you provide your child with a pair of labeled wellington boots. If possible, we ask that these remain in school to ensure we are able to learn outside in all weathers.

Phonics

Over the term we will be helping children to develop their reading and writing skills by having a big focus on our daily phonics activities. Parent videos will be available on Google Classroom along with videos for your child to watch at home. We will soon be introducing your child to school reading books for you to share together at home. It is vital for your child's literacy development that you share these together and read as often as possible at home. Reading records will also be provided in order for you to record their reading experiences. More information on reading at home will be shared with you shortly.
