Introduction

St. Joseph's Federation BASC offers wrap around care For children aged 4 and above and exists to provide high quality out-of-school hours childcare for our parents for our children.

It provides a range of stimulating and creative activities in a safe environment. We provide a healthy breakfast in line with Croydon Council Food Standard Agency.

Breakfast Club

St. Joseph's Breakfast Club is a drop in service for all St. Joseph's Children.

The service opens at 7.45am and last breakfast is served at 8.30am. We are not able to admit children after 8.40am.

For breakfast children can choose from a range of cereals, juice and toast with a variety of toppings.

After breakfast children take part in a range of activities until the school day begins.

Each breakfast session costs £6 with a reduced fee of £5 per session if booking 4 or 5 sessions each week; **£2/session for any child who is eligible for pupil premium.**

Afterschool Club

The afterschool club from 3pm- 6pm. Each session costs The after school club is for £12 per session, £10 if booking 4 or 5 sessions each week; **£6/session for any child who is eligible for pupil premium.**

We will offer children:

- A wide variety of fun and stimulating activities
- Access to outdoor play
- Access to a quiet area for reading and relaxation
- Support with homework if required
- An opportunity to socialise with other children

All parents/carers must complete and sign a registration form prior to their child attending the club/s.

- Only children attending St Joseph's RC Federation are eligible to attend our club.
- All places are subject to availability.
- Non contracted pupils are welcomed to use the club provided there are spaces and parents/carers have previously completed a registration form.
- Parents/Carers must bring their child directly to the Garden Hall and sign them in.
- Parents/Carers must provide details of any allergies or medical conditions to the school prior to their child attending the Breakfast/After School Club.

Payment of Fees

Users of the Breakfast Club will be charged through Arbor in advance.

- Fees are to be paid in advance. If payment is not received by the date of the first session the school reserves the right to withdraw the childcare place.
- Payment is due for all contracted sessions even if your child is unable to attend their booked session. No refunds will be made for any sessions missed.
- Payment can be made by Childcare vouchers, your Tax Free childcare account or through Arbor. The School has registered as a childcare provider under the Government Tax Free Childcare Scheme. Parents can find out if they are eligible by visiting www.childcarechoices.gov.uk.
- Four weeks notice must be given to reduce the number of sessions your child attends at the Breakfast/Afterschool Club.
- Six weeks notice must be given to cancel your child's place.

All communication and messages concerning Breakfast Club should be via the school office
